treating fibrosis

Fibrosis can present at all stages of lymphedema. Fibrotic tissue needs to be softened in order to properly transport lymph. Lympha Press systems have the adjustable pressures needed to treat fibrotic areas.

treatment options

Peristaltic and sequential modes, pre- and post-therapy options, single extremity and bilateral garments designed to treat lymphedema and lipedema. The optimal treatment plan is available.

protocol

- Lympha Press settings allow the medical practitioner to individualize patient treatments according to need, comfort and response. (Frequency and duration of treatment can vary)
- Pressure is set according to physician prescription (required).

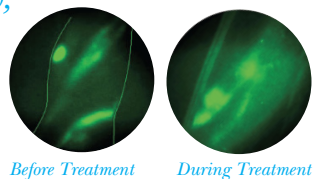
indications for use

- Primary lymphedema
- Secondary lymphedema
- Dysfunction of the muscle pump
- Venous insufficiency
- Venous stasis ulcers

contraindications

- Known or suspected deep vein thrombosis or pulmonary embolism
- During the inflammatory phlebitis process
- Acute infection of the affected limb
- Decompensated cardiac failure
- Severe arteriosclerosis or other ischemic vascular disease
- Any circumstance where increased venous and lymphatic return is undesirable
